

Planning for chaos

The domain of chaos entered purposely represents innovation. If entered accidentally it can be a crisis. The main danger is an entry from simple (complacency leads to failure). Crisis management can be achieved by the imposition of rigid constraints chaos to simple) or by a more resilient approach in which rapid actions reduce turbulence, allowing a safe fail experimental approach to be used (chaos to complex)
